# Understanding Outcomes and the “All About Me” Section A

## Who is this work shop for?

This work shop is a **MUST** for any parents/carers of Year 6 pupils with Statements. However, it is also helpful training for professionals who would like to attend.

## What is it about?

Given the recent changes in the Special Educational Needs Law, the most significant for 30 years, it’s vital for you to understand what you need to do, to ensure a successful conversion of your child’s Statement to an Education, Health and Care Plan. This will be happening for Year 6 pupils in the next few months.

The aim of the work shop will be to:

- Provide the context and a brief overview of the changes
- Understand your role and responsibilities in this
- Learn some of the key principles and how to develop “Outcomes” which underpin the Plan
- Familiarise yourself with the new system and paperwork, starting to think about how to complete the first section, Section A “ All about me”
- Find out what to expect from your EHCP conversion meetings as well as next steps and actions
